Operator wants it moderated; historical evidence shows no intention/commitment to have org.za as a moderated SLD



Net.za (dormant)

Net.za draft charter shows intention to have the SLD as moderated, but the charter was never approved

- Ac.uk: for academic establishments
- co.uk: for commercial enterprises
- gov.uk: for government bodies
- me.uk: for personal domains
- org.uk: for non-commercial organisations
- Itd.uk: for registered company names only
- plc.uk: for registered company names only
- net.uk: for Internet Service Providers
- sch.uk: for schools

Let's compare with .AU

- com.au: for commercial entities
- net.au: for commercial entities
- org.au: for charities and non-profit organisations
- gov.au: for government bodies
- edu.au: for registered educational institutions



Let's compare with .NZ

• ac.za: un-moderated (???)

• co.nz: un-moderated

net.nz: un-moderated

org.nz: un-moderated

school.nz:un-moderated



Let's compare with .KE

- ac.ke: academic institutions (moderated)
- co.ke: companies (moderated)
- ne.ke: network devices (un-moderated)
- org.nz: NPOs & NGOs (un-moderated)
- mobi.ke: mobile content (un-moderated)
- me.ke: personal names (un-moderated)

Let's compare with gTLDs

• .com: un-moderated

.gov: moderated (for US govts)

• org.nz: un-moderated

net.nz: un-moderated

• .travel: defined community, but un-moderated

.web: new gTLD, un-moderated

So, what are the issues?

- Limited or no documentary evidence proving moderation or no moderation of several SLDs
 - ZADNA has to rely on inherited practice
- Currently, only co.za is an active, un-moderated SLD
 - Does this limit consumer choice?
- Most SLDs do not have documented policies and procedures
- Should you introduce new SLDs? Why?



So, what are the issues?

Net.za – to re-open for new registrations?

- Should it be moderated or un-moderated?
- Can you define "network infrastructure operator"?
- Will you require network providers registered in co.za to migrate to net.za?
- Should we follow .net gTLD?

Org.za

- Moderation vs no moderation
- Does it continue as a virtually free domain?
- Should we follow .org gTLD?
